**Prize Giving:** 4.30pm All prizes awarded even if the day is cancelled.

**Prizes:** 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, ... Snapper, Gurnard, Kahawai and one featured species. Only one of each of these 4 species to be weighed in by each angler.

**3 Sisters aggregate prize:** a bucket containing one each of snapper, kahawai and gurnard can be weighed in, one bucket per boat per day. Any incomplete set on any of the combination of 3 will not be eligible for a prize and your fish must be caught on your boat. The closest to the average of all buckets over the 4 days of competition will win the major prize to be announced at prize giving on Easter Saturday.

# TOURNAMENT RULES

## ELIGIBILITY:

All crew must be paid up entrants. **(No Passengers)**

All entries must be on the official entry forms and fees paid in full.

Individually numbered wristbands issued by tournament registration must be worn at all times during tournament events. All boats must depart and return from the MMBC ramp.

**The number of entrants is limited to around 200 people. Skippers and their boats must be MMBC members.**

## RESPONSIBILITY:

**Lifejackets must be worn when crossing the bar (both ways) – anyone seen not doing so, will result in the entire boat being disqualified.**

The Skipper is responsible for properly equipping the boat, for the safe operation of the boat and the safety of all on board.

The Skipper is responsible for ensuring compliance with Maritime Safety Rules and Standards; Manawatu River and Tributaries Navigation and Safety Bylaws and Ministry of Fisheries Recreational Fishing Rules. Any boat found to be in breach of these rules will be disqualified.

All entrants must abide by the Manawatu Marine Boating Club Inc's Club rules.

The Skipper is responsible for ensuring that all crew are aware and accept the tournament rules. Your signed entry form to the tournament is confirmation that you and your crew have read and accept the tournament rules and conditions. (Boats and equipment may be scrutinized at the tournament organizers discretion.)

## FISHING METHODS:

Only rods or hand lines with a maximum of 5 hooks per line may be used or carried on the boat.

(No setlines, set nets or fish traps to be carried on the boat.)

**BOUNDARY:** Fishing must be north of the Ohau River (S40° 39.70') and south of the Rangitikei River mouth (S40° 16.78').

## WEIGH IN:

The weigh station will be open from 12.00pm to 3.00pm each day.

If you have a fish to be weighed, you must be standing in the queue at the weigh station wearing your registration wristband before 3.00pm.

**Only one fish of each species to be weighed per angler.**

**Do not gut gill or bleed fish.**

Weigh station staff may cut or gut fish after weighing to confirm fish has been weighed or if tampering is suspected. Any tampering detected will result in immediate disqualification of the boat and its crew from the tournament.

Each fish may only be weighed and entered once. If you dispute the weight, state this while the fish is on the scales; the staff will check their reading/recording and their decision will become final.

Undersized fish, according to Ministry of Fisheries Recreational Fishing regulations, will not be weighed.

In the event of a tie, the first fish weighed will be deemed the winner.

**All Snapper entries will have a maximum length of 600mm. Longer snapper will not be considered for any prize.**

**CANCELLATIONS:** Will be notified on a board displayed in the Club foyer, broadcast on VHF radio channel 60. If cancelled, all prizes will be by lottery using the entrants' numbers. If cancelled, skippers must still attend at 8.00am to collect the wristbands for their crew, which must be worn at prizegiving.

**PRIZEGIVINGS:** Will be held at 4.30pm upstairs by the pool tables in the boat club. **YOU MUST BE PRESENT AND WEARING YOUR WRISTBAND TO CLAIM A SPOT PRIZE.**

**TIMES:** 8.00am Skippers collect wristbands for their boat and attend safety briefing – featured species named.

The Coastguard will inspect bar conditions prior to the start regarding the commencement of competition for that day. Times may be delayed or altered on the day by Tournament Organisers and such changes will be noted on a board displayed in the club foyer and broadcast on VHF Channel 60.

Any protest must be made in writing to the Fishing Co-Ordinator by 4.00pm on the day of the competition.

The decisions of the Tournament Organizers will be final and binding. No correspondence will be entered into.

## 2021 Super Quad Fishing Series

There will be 4 one day competitions from January through to Easter Saturday. This change allows us to be flexible enough to adjust, rather than cancel, if Covid levels change unexpectedly.

**Competition Dates:** January 16<sup>th</sup>, February 13<sup>th</sup>, March 13<sup>th</sup>, April 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The Competitions will be for **MMBC members' boats only**. Guests of MMBC skippers who are non-MMBC members will be able to register if places allow – first in first served! There will be a maximum limit of **200 people** for each competition day with no age restrictions. **Entries close on the Sunday BEFORE each competition day**. Each competition can only be entered and paid for separately for that month (no season tickets available).

**Cost:** \$30 per person per competition day. Entry forms and rules are available at the club bar or can be downloaded from the MMBC website, scanned and emailed back to [mmbcfishing@gmail.com](mailto:mmbcfishing@gmail.com)

**Rules:** Skippers must familiarise themselves with the rules and sign the back of the entry form to agree that they and their crew will follow them.

**Prizes:** There will be a range of prizes for snapper, gurnard and kahawai and one other featured species each month. Only one of each of the 4 species can be weighed in by each angler.

**Prize-Giving:** Will be held at 4.30pm on the day of each competition and all sponsored prizes will be given out over the course of the 4 months. If fishing has to be cancelled due to weather, the prize giving will still go ahead and the prize pool for all categories that day given out as **spot prizes**. **If the day is cancelled skippers must still collect the wristbands for their crew at 8.00am.**

**NB: Participants must be wearing their wristband to win a spot prize.**

**The Three Sisters:** As part of the Super Quad Series, there will be the “**Three Sisters**” competition. Each boat can enter one bucket containing a set - one gurnard, one snapper and one kahawai (the 3 sisters). The weight of the 3 fish will make up the entry weight. A major aggregate prize will be awarded on Easter Saturday to the boat that weighs in the bucket closest to average of all the sets of 3, across the 4 competition days. You do not have had to participate in all 4 days and you do not have to be present on Easter Saturday to receive this major prize if your boat is the winner, hence the wristband is not required for the aggregate prize.
