

Sailing Boats

We have a boat suitable for anyone, from young beginner, an adult wanting to experience sailing to someone who would like to get back into sailing. You can sail one of the single-handed boats or go out on one of our multi-person boats. We are able to supply life jackets but suitable clothing for dinghy sailing is not available. You would be most comfortable in a wet suit.

How to go about Boat Hire.

If you are interested in hiring one of these boats, please contact Rob Elder, 021 414 040, to discuss your requirements, i.e. whether you are learning to sail and require tuition or if you are an experienced sailor.

The sailing programme shows the days and times that we sail. You would need to arrive 90 minutes before the given start time so that we move you smoothly through all of the steps leading up to going on the water.

Open Skiff (BIC)

The Open Skiff is a modern, high-performance sailing dinghy designed for junior sailors to promote fun, adventure, and skill development

Unlike traditional beginner boats, it features a fast, planing hull and an open transom, which provides a dynamic sailing experience similar to an adult Skiff

Fee: \$100 for a season or \$15 per day



RS Feva

The RS Feva is an internationally recognized, two-person dinghy designed for young sailors and family teams, known for its performance, ease of use, and as a stepping stone to a lifetime of sailing. It is manufactured by RS Sailing, features a durable roto-moulded plastic hull, and can be sailed with a mainsail alone, or with a mainsail and jib and a spinnaker for more advanced racing.

Fee: \$100 for a season or \$15 per day per person



Laser

The Laser is a popular class of single-handed, one-design sailing dinghy renowned for its simplicity, competitive racing, and performance. A great boat for an older teenager and all adults. This is the main boat sailed by our adult fleet.

Fee: \$300 for a season or \$30 per day



SeaBird

A rather stately boat on which we can take out even the most inexperienced or uncertain person out to experience sailing.

Fee: \$200 for a season or \$20 per day
